RULES FOR EXHIBITING:

Paintings must be **NEW, ORIGINAL WORKS**. The work must **not** have been exhibited in any show in the Armstrong Spallumcheen Art Gallery (hereafter called "the Gallery") prior to this Ribbon Show.

Each entry must be suitably **wired/prepared** for hanging, and be identified on the back with its title, medium, and price, as well as the artist's name, address, and phone number. (Price should include the Gallery's 30% commission). If not for sale please provide value for insurance purposes.

As the Gallery or its agents will **NOT** be responsible for the insurance of works of art while they are in the Gallery's or its agent's possession, it is recommended the artist insure their work.

When a work is sold, a cheque for the purchase price will be made payable to the Armstrong Spallumcheen Museum and Arts Society. The Gallery's commission will be 30% of the selling price. A cheque to the artist for the remaining 70% of the purchase price will be issued after the close of the show. All art work is subject to PST. In the event of an out-of-town buyer: if a work must be shipped, the artist is expected to make arrangements for packing and shipping. The purchaser normally pays the shipping charges.

No works may be repositioned or removed by the artist or a buyer during the period of the show.

The Gallery has the right to refuse artwork for any reason.

The Gallery has the right to place, in the appropriate category, a work, which does not meet the standard criteria of the category in which it was first entered.

The Curator of the Gallery and/or a committee of the Gallery will be responsible for hanging the works. Artists are not permitted to rearrange the display.

Artists are responsible for the delivery of their work to the Gallery between 10 am and 3 pm on June 28th, 2022. They are also responsible for collecting it between 2 pm and 4 pm on Fri., August 5th or 10 am and 3 pm on Sat., Aug. 6th, 2022 (unless alternate arrangements are made at least one week in advance of the opening or closing of the show). Because of space limitations at the Gallery, works cannot be stored longer than one week following the close of the show.

Space constraints are a consideration in the Gallery. Please take this into account when choosing your pieces for entry in this exhibition. **Frame must be no larger than 24" x 36"**.
